Many Promise Programs!

- Local Promise Programs – Have existed in some districts for 10 years
- National push for Free Community College Promise Programs
- California College Promise Innovation Grant Program – 2016
\$15,000,000 in block grants
- California College Promise Grant (Formerly the Board of Governors Fee Waiver)
- AB 19 California College Promise – fee waivers and/or increased student support



AB 19 – California College Promise

- “Free Tuition” for first year, first time/full-time students”
 - First time college students
 - Attending full-time (12 units)
 - No financial need required
- Allows colleges to waive fees or provide student support in other ways



AB 19 Goals

- Increase the % of HS students who are prepared for college directly from high school
- Increase the % of students who earn AA, AS or certificates
- Increase transfers to CSU, UC



AB 19 Goals

- Reduce regional achievement gaps and achievement gaps for underrepresented students
 - current or former foster youth
 - students with disabilities
 - formerly incarcerated students
 - undocumented students
 - AB 540 eligible students
 - students who are veterans



Requirements to participate in AB 19

- Partner with local educational agencies to learn about, visit and prepare for college
- Partner with LEAs to support and improve HS preparation for college and reduce postsecondary remediation through small learning communities, concurrent enrollment, and other evidence-based practices.
- Utilize evidence-based assessment



Requirements to participate in AB 19

- Participate in the CC Guided Pathways Program
- Require students to complete the FAFSA or CADAA
- Require CC participation in federal student loan programs

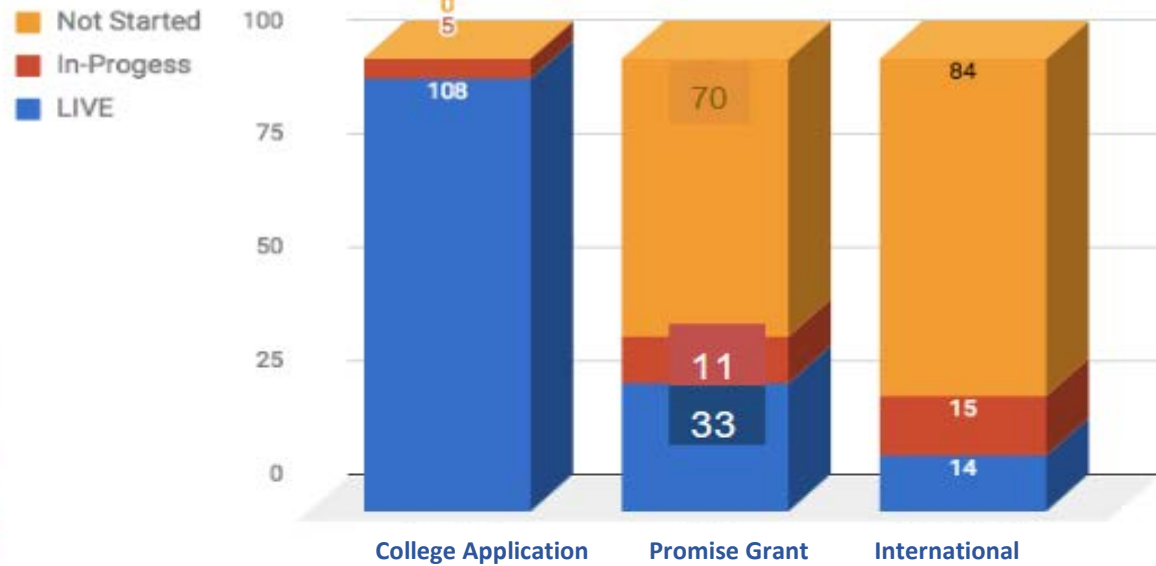

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The Education Planning Initiative (EPI)

Is developing a student services portal that will customize and sequence matriculation information and activities to lead students toward successful completion of their goals, and an Education Planning and Degree Audit System to provide transcript, articulation, and curriculum inventory elements to colleges and help college counselors reach more students.

MyPath

A college-customizable guided pathways tool that pulls in information about the student from various systems, and presents a customized, prescriptive user experience that is individualized for every student. MyPath promotes student success by engaging and guiding the student during the matriculation process, and beyond.



Project Glue

An integration architecture which will standardize communications between colleges, the Technology Center and the CCC Chancellor's Office

The Project Glue architecture has three main parts:

- College Adapter - software behind college firewall for secure data transfer

- Standardized Data – works with all college SIS and provides SIS flexibility

- MDM Data Exchange – Single point of reference for both reading and writing data

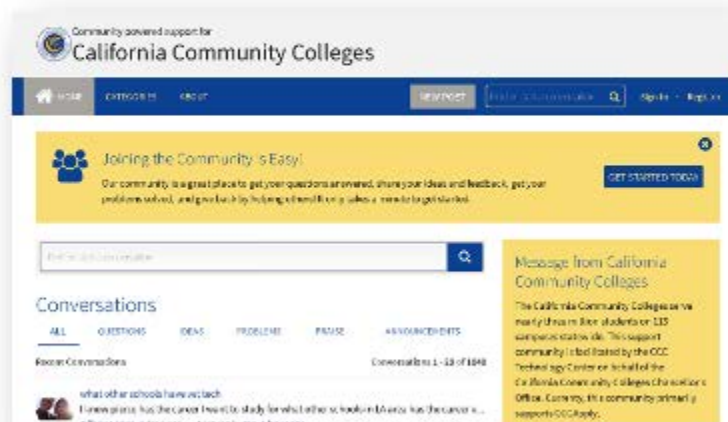
