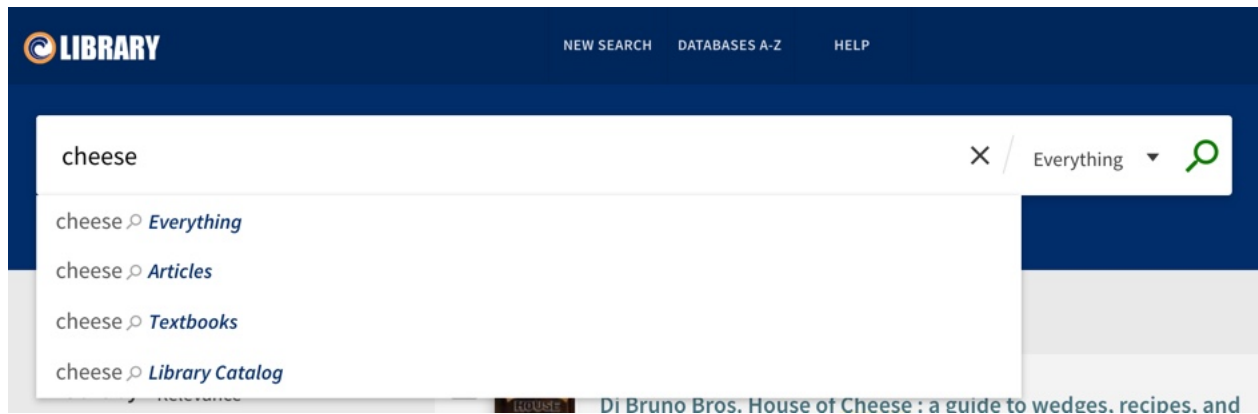


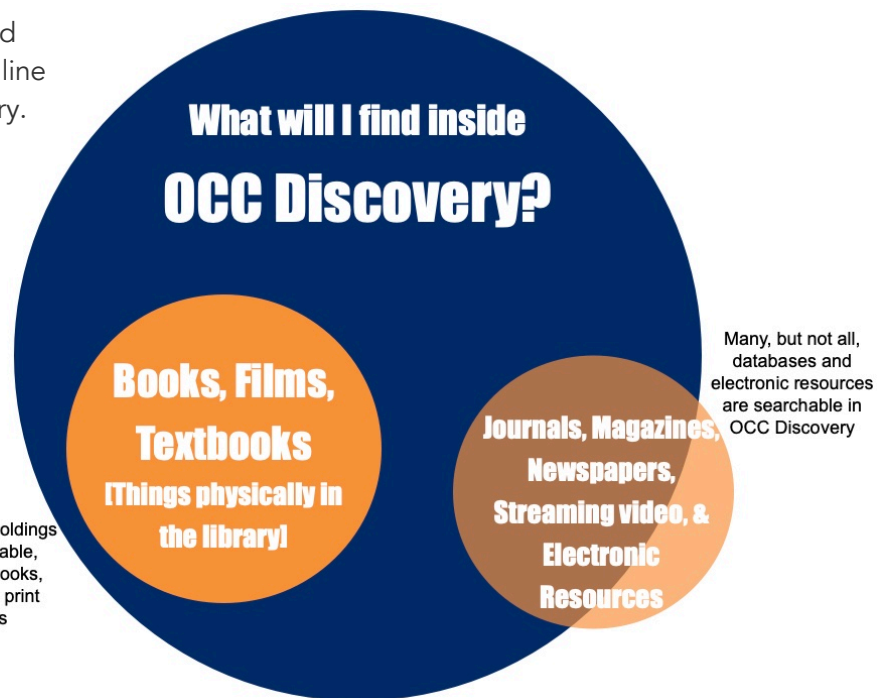
# OCC Discovery **A new way to search the Library!**

The OCC Library has implemented a new library catalog and search tool, allowing you to search print and e-books, films and documentaries, articles, and electronic resources in one place.



## What am I searching?

- **Everything:** This is the broadest search. Find books, e-books, DVDs, and many of the online resources available through the OCC Library.
- **Articles:** Find online articles that are available through the OCC Library. *Note:* This does not include all of the online articles available through the databases in which the library subscribes. To search in a specific database, go to the [A-Z Database List](#).
- **Textbooks:** Search for textbooks and reserves for your OCC classes.
- **Library Catalog:** Search for books, DVDs, and other items physically available in the library.



## How do I start searching?

- **Choose Your Search Option:** Choose what you want to search in the OCC Discovery by using the dropdown menu next to the search box (see image above). Then, type in your keywords and press Enter.

## I started my search. Now what do I do?

Searching will bring you to the results page of OCC Discovery. From this page, you have the option to sign in to your library account, narrow your search in multiple ways, click on titles to see full details, pin items to your Favorites, and more.

You will likely receive many (like tens of thousands) search results. Using the filters on the left hand navigation bar will help you get the type of results you want. Use the following drop downs to narrow your results:

- Resource Type: To select only articles, books, reference entries, videos, etc.
- Date: To determine when the results were published (e.g. last ten years)
- Genre: To select only encyclopedias, nonfiction, fiction, documentaries, etc.
