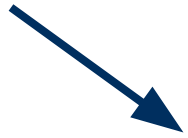

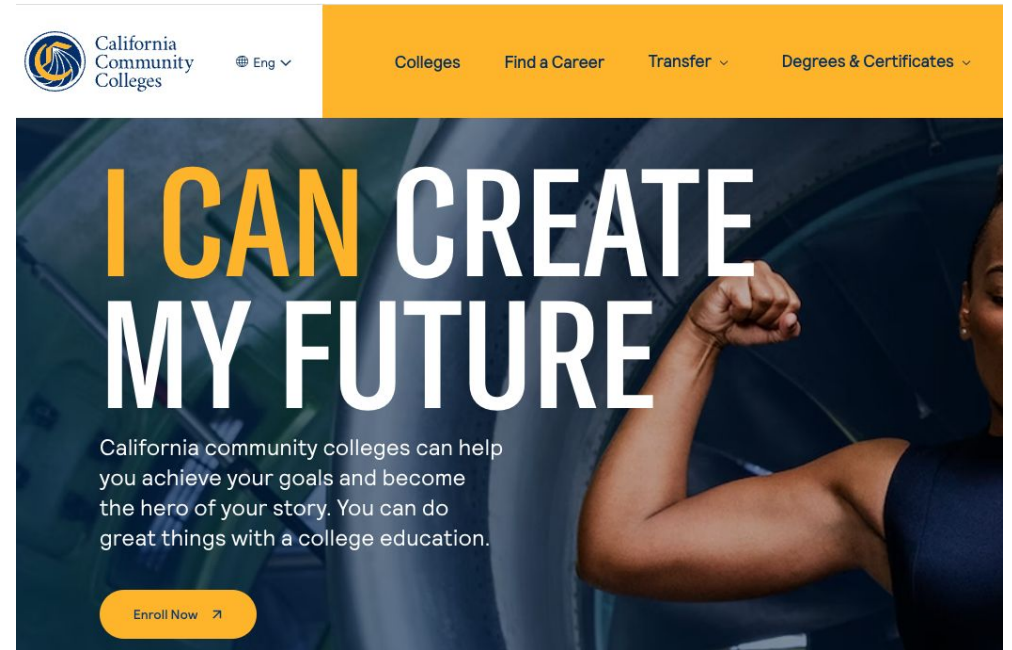

Next Gen “CCCGo” Demo

- **Demo shows off capabilities of the new architecture**
 - It’s all real! Real code, code libraries, and integrated tools
 - Now the hard part: consensus on how to streamline and tailor the standard application
 - CCCCO sponsored task force for CCCApply

- Future-proofing the system with updated architecture
- Streamlining the user experience
- Addressing friction points
- Reducing unintended impacts on underrepresented students

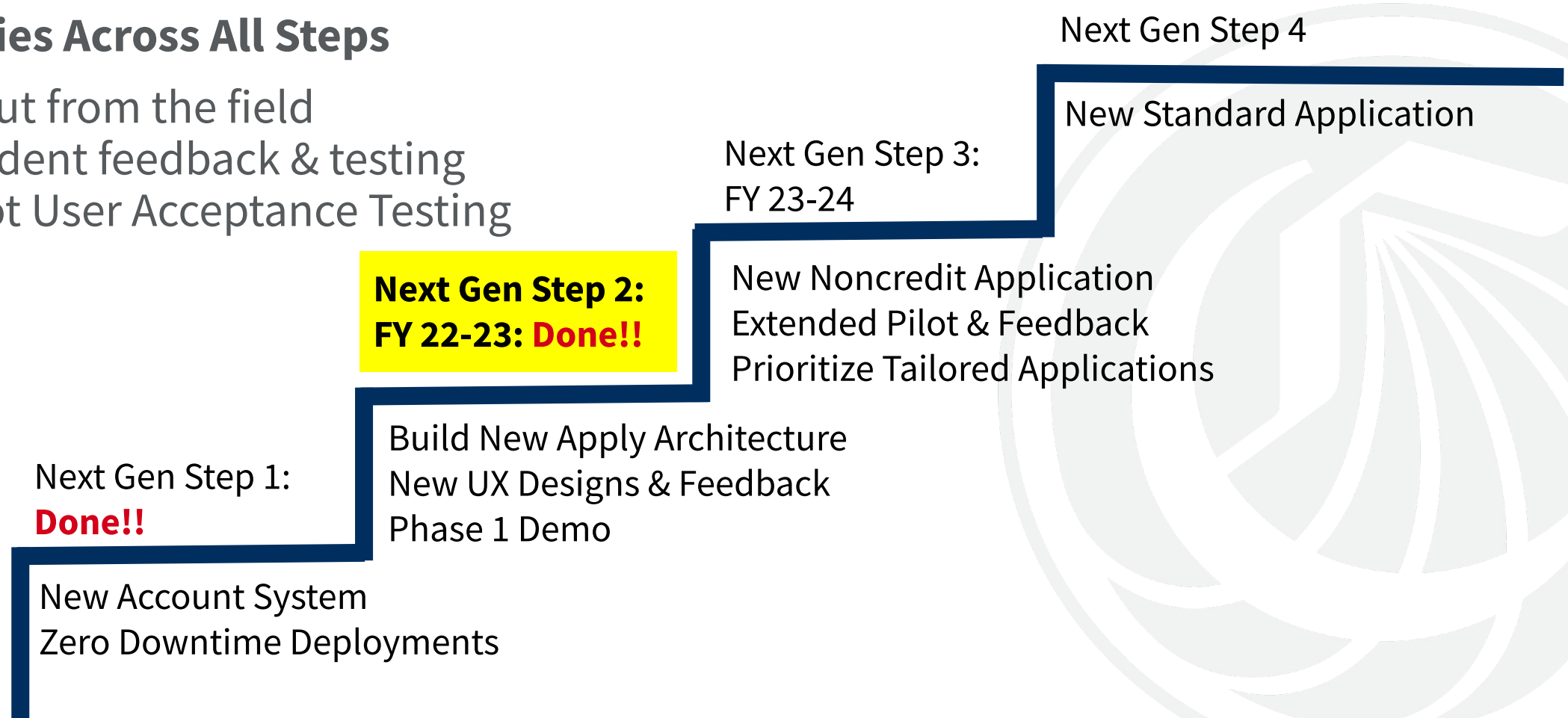
CCCGo Benefits

- Replace existing CCCApply technology with modern, more secure and flexible architecture
 - Allows tailored workflows targeted to specific student groups
- A streamlined user experience gives students a better start on their academic and career goals
- Ability to track and eliminate obstacles to student onboarding

Steps to the Next Gen Application

Activities Across All Steps

- Input from the field
- Student feedback & testing
- Pilot User Acceptance Testing



Build New Apply Architecture

A modern technology stack and microservices-based platform

- Modern, Mobile-First User Interface Design
- Streamlined Business Logic
- Enhanced Data Delivery Mechanisms
- Robust, transparent system operations
- Enhanced Analytics Platform with User-Friendly Analytical Tools
- Base SSS 2.0 Architecture in place with Phase 1 Demo deliverable (using working code). Additional phases can now build on top of that.



What's Next?

- Noncredit workflow as first release
 - Includes the same fields as the standard app, minus residency and citizenship
 - Fast development with less risk
 - Earlier beta testing and feedback
 - Feedback that improves standard app development too!
- Socialization plan / Feedback / Buy-in

CALIFORNIA NONRESIDENT TUITION EXEMPTION REQUEST
Education Code § 68130.5, as amended, commonly known as AB 540

INSTRUCTIONS
Complete and sign this form to request exemption from nonresident tuition charged to nonresident students. Once determined to be eligible, you will continue to receive the exemption as long as you fulfill eligibility requirements or until the College or University no longer offers this exemption. Applying for this exemption does not alter your responsibility to pay, by the campus deadline, any nonresident tuition and associated fees that may be due before your eligibility is determined.

* A year's equivalence at a California Community College is either a minimum of 24 semester units of credit or 36 quarter units. For noncredit courses, a year's attendance is a minimum of 420 class hours per year (a semester is equivalent to a minimum of 210 hours and a quarter is equivalent to a minimum of 140 hours). Full-time attendance at a California adult school is a minimum of 420 hours of attendance for each school year.

Quick Updates

- High School Outreach
- CCCApply Download Client End-of-Life
- Spam Filter Enhancement



High School Outreach

- Remind students NOT to use their high school email on the OpenCCC account!
- Students lose access to this email and cannot recover their OpenCCC account
- Encourage use of student's personal email (not a parent/family email)

Final Days!! Download Client EOL

- Two months to the Download Client Phase Out deadline!
 - Download Client NOT maintained after July 1, 2023
- Recent SuperGlue releases include MANY student fields not available through the DL Client

Spam Filter Enhancement

- Released into Production April 12, 2023 (yesterday!)
- Pilot test results show a much higher percentage of fraudulent apps caught
- Slight increase in false positives (legitimate apps caught in spam filter)
 - Whitelist via staff support
