- Modern, Mobile-First User Interface Design
- Streamlined Business Logic
- Enhanced Data Delivery Mechanisms
- Robust, transparent system operations
- Enhanced Analytics Platform with User-Friendly Analytical Tools
- Base SSS 2.0 Architecture in place with Phase 1 Demo deliverable (using working code). Additional phases can now build on top of that.





What's Next?

- Noncredit workflow as first release
 - Includes the same fields as the standard app, minus residency and citizenship
 - Fast development with less risk
 - Earlier beta testing and feedback
 - Feedback that improves standard app development too!

CALIFORNIA NONRESIDENT TUITION EXEMPTION REQUEST Education Code § 68130.5, as amended, commonly known as AB 540

INSTRUCTIONS

Once determined to be eligible, you will continue to receive the exemption as long as you fulfill eligibility requirements or until the College or University no longer offers this exemption. Quick Updates

- High School Outreach
- CCCApply Download Client End-of-Life
- Spam Filter Enhancement



High School Outreach

- Remind students NOT to use their high school email on the OpenCCC account!
 - Students lose access to this email and cannot recover their OpenCCC account
 - Encourage use of student's personal email (not a parent/family email)



Final Days!! Download Client EOL

- Two months to the Download Client Phase Out deadline!
 - Download Client NOT maintained after July 1, 2023
- Recent SuperGlue releases include MANY student fields not available through the DL Client



Spam Filter Enhancement

- Released into Production April 12, 2023 (yesterday!)
- Pilot test results show a much higher percentage of fraudulent apps caught
- Slight increase in false positives (legitimate apps caught in spam filter)
 - Whitelist via staff support
