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Document Purpose

The CCCApply International Application Specification provides a blueprint for the development and maintenance (upgrade releases) of the application. The content includes application user interface design and logic, and database table information underlying the application.

The CCCApply International Application Specification is intended for two audiences:

- California Community Colleges Tech Center (CCCTC) staff, including software designers, developers, QA technicians, technical writers, and project managers for the CCCApply International Application
- California Community College staff that works with implementation, configuration, usage, and download of data from the CCCApply International Application



Note: Since this document serves two audiences, it is good to note that some information may display as "inprogress" and will be noted as such to avoid confusion.

Overview

The CCCApply International Application is a multipage online form that provides a complete application to a particular California Community College for international students. It is accessed from either each college's portal/website or from eccapply.org.

The CCCApply International Application user interface includes:

- A page for initiating and managing applications (My International Applications)
- Application form pages for the student to enter information to apply co college
- An electronically-signed submission page
- Post-submission pages including a confirmation page and a page of links to system-wide information such as financial aid applications and other related opportunities.

The CCCApply International Application Form also includes several 'smart' features:

- College-configured data and content using the Administrator (terms list, majors list, English proficiency, rules, supplemental questions, etc.)
- · Validation logic that prevents conflicting responses and flags situations that colleges might want to investigate
- Other determinations, such as admission eligibility
- Presentation of links based on applicant-entered data
- · Auto-population of form data from the applicant's OpenCCC Account

Supporting Resources

The following resources are available to support the CCCApply International Application.

- **cccapply.org:** The cccapply.org website is where students apply to college. For the CCCApply International application, the cccapply.org web site will require modifications similar to what was made for the CCCApply Standard application. We will need to send applicants to the college's website as the starting point for applying for the international application.

Each section (represented by tabs) must be completed and pass field/page validation before the applicant is allowed to move on to the next section.

Field Conventions

The following field conventions and display are used throughout the CCCApply International Application.

Conditional Questions and Fields	In general, CCCApply applications will conditionally display only the questions and fields that need to be asked based on responses to earlier questions (including account data elements). The conditions determining whether a question displays is identified in the submitted application database tables section of this document.
Dates	Date questions use menus for month and day, and a text field for the four-digit year.
	Dates displayed in the user interface are in the format of month day, year (i.e. May 06, 2015).
	Dates will always be subject to the following basic error checks, in addition to any other error checking required:
	The day must be valid for the month and year.
	The year must be four digits and not before 1900.
	No general maximum date is needed since most (if not all) date fields have error checking for a particular maximum date.
Language Toggle	The CCCApply application pages include a language toggle similar to the one in the former XAP applications. However, the language toggle in CCCApply affects only the language of the field 'hover help'. All other application language always displays in English.

Application Page Flow

Applicants are first presented and must sign in to the OpenCCC Federated ID system before, or immediately after, navigating to CCCApply. An introduction page may display before the applicant signs in, prompting the user to either create an account or sign in.

- If the applicant click Create Account, the OpenCCC Create Your OpenCCC Account page displays, and the user is prompted to create an OpenCCC account.
- When the applicant clicks Sign In, the OpenCCC Sign In page displays, and the user is prompted to enter their Username and Password.

My International Applications Page

Once logged in, the applicant views the My International Applications page.



Note: District applications are distinguished by displaying on both the My International Applications page and the Enrollment page of the application. A district application is an application to a college which has more than one college in the district. If there is more than one row in the college table with the same district_id as the current college, then it is a district application. The current college is the college from which the applicant initiated the application process.

CCCApply International Application Pages

Application pages (tabs) have the following dependencies as outlined in the table below.

Automatic Field Population

Some fields are auto-populated in the CCCApply International application.

The Account/Address Information fields auto-populate with the following data from the applicant's OpenCCC account:

Note: The *Current Mailing Address* and *Non U.S. Permanent Address* fields can be populated from the user's OpenCCC Account *Permanent Address* fields by clicking the checkbox that indicates the addresses are the same.

US Address verification for US mailing addresses is the same process used in CCCApply Standard Application. US addresses are validated using the **CASS** (U.S. Postal Service) address validation system. This includes the addresses entered in the OpenCCC Account Creation process.

The following two auto-populated fields refer to an in-progress table where data is stored temporarily until the student submits their application:

The **app** id is automatically generated when the row is first inserted into the table.


The **college_id** is set from the college table. It is the MIS code for the college being applied to.

My International Applications

The My International Applications page is presented once the user has signed into their OpenCCC account. From My International Applications, they can:

1. Start a new application.

- **2.** Resume or Delete an in-progress application.
- **3.** View a submitted application.



The My International Applications page processes applications as follows:

In-Progress Applications


- Display all in-progress applications for any college in the California Community Colleges District for the signedin user. When the applicant clicks **Resume** for one of the in-progress applications:
 - Change the current college to the college of the In-Progress application.
 - Change the "brand" to be the college of the In-Progress application.
 - All terms, majors, etc. should be those of the In-Progress application.

Submitted Applications

Display all submitted applications for the signed-in user regardless of which college the application is for.

Introduction Page

The first page in the CCCApply International application is an introductory page of instructions for filling out the application.



Enrollment Information

The Enrollment Information page includes three drop-down list fields and a freeform entry field.

- 1. Term Applying For
- 2. Intended Major or Program of Study
- 3. Educational Goal
- 4. Freeform field: "Enter your intended 4 year major if different than the one you selected above:"

The three drop-down field values are defined by each individual college in the Administrator. See the Administrator Guide for details on configuring these values.

Enrollment Page Validation

Applicants cannot apply to the same college for the same term. For district applications, an applicant may apply to only one college within the district for a given term. The following logic will enforce this rule. The following steps should occur when the Continue button is clicked:

- 1. Perform all other verifications for the enrollment screen to ensure all data is valid.
- 2. Find all colleges for the district. Find all college rows with the same district_id as the current college. If there is only one, it is not a district application. If there is more than one, continue.
- 3. Check for In-Progress applications. For each college_id other than the college_id of the current college, check if there is an in-progress application for the user for the same term. If true, this is an error that will render the page incomplete and not allow the user to complete the application (dee error message below).
- 4. Check for submitted applications. For each college_id other than the college_id of the current college, check if there is a submitted application for the user for the same term. If true, this is an error that will render the page incomplete and not allow the user to complete the application (see error message below).

Account and Mailing Information

The Account/Address Information page fields are auto-populated with values the applicant entered when they created their OpenCCC Account.

When the user selects the Current Mailing Address check box to indicate that their mailing address is the same as their permanent address in their OpenCCC Account, the fields for this text box collapse and are not displayed.





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

- · Sevis information
- · Optional/Curricular Practical Training



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Supplemental Questions

The supplemental questions page will function the same way as it does in the CCCApply Standard application. The setup for the page will use an XML file for its definition and will use the Administrator to import the page. Using supplemental questions is optional for each college. See the Administrator Guide and the Supplemental Questions Guide for details on configuring supplemental questions for the CCCApply applications.

When supplemental questions are configured by the college to be used in the CCCApply International application, the Supplemental Questions page appears prior to the Consent page.

Consent

The Consent page presents the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office consent language and two radio buttons for the student to select:

- I consent
- I do not consent


Request for Consent to Release Information

Additional Requirements

The following additional requirements are under consideration for implementation of the CCCApply International Application.

Advance Payment



Note: This requirement will not be implemented in the first iteration/release. The Steering Committee will work with the SSPSC to discuss an integrated payment processing system into the SS Portal to be used for multi-purposes, such as transcripts, admission application fees, and more.

Advance payment is required before submitting an application. Forms of payment include:

- 1. Credit Card. Investigate use of Paypal or some similar third party payment system.
- **2.** Check. Would this need to be some form of a certified check?
- 3. Wire transfer.
- 4. Assuming any form of payment will need to be in US currency?

This requirement will require the ability for college staff to mark an in-progress application to indicate payment has been received and cleared so the application can be submitted. Once the payment has been recorded notification to the applicant is required.

Business Process Management

In the XAP system, there is an optional Workflow Manager which can be purchased and used with the older International application. In the new CCCApply International Application, Business Process Management software will be used for workflow management. This section describes the requirements for this process.

Application Downloads

Application data will be available for colleges to download using the same technology and Download client software that is used for the CCCApply and the OpenCCC BOG Fee Waiver application.

The download process is documented in the CCCApply Download Client guide found on our project site at http://cccapplyproject.org/documentation#user-guides

Administrator

The functions available in the Administrator for the CCCApply International Application include:

- 1. Term management
- 2. Majors management
- 3. English Proficiency
- 4. Supplemental Questions
- 5. Rules
- 6. Reset Downloads
- 7. User Authorization

Reporting

All submitted applications from CCCApply International Application (and previously-submitted applications from the older XAP International application) will be available in the Report Center. The Report Center provides the following report types:

- 1. Public standard reports.
- 2. Public lookup reports such as name with a link to view the full application.
- 3. Ad Hoc reporting for any reportable field on the application.

Individual authorization for use of the Report Center is controlled in the Administrator. Authorization restricts a user to viewing applications for their specific college or district. See the Report Center guide located here:

Similar to the CCCApply Standard Application, the CCCApply International Application makes use of several inprogress tables, where data is stored in real-time as the applicant enters values and saves the application. The inprogress table data is then stored in a submitted application table upon application submission.

The following in-progress support tables are common and used to store in-progress applicant data for both the CCCApply Standard Application and the CCCApply International Application:

The following in-progress support tables have their own international "version," unique to the CCCApply International Application. These tables are updated from college configuration in the Administrator.

Once the applicant submits the CCCApply International Application, all values from the in-progress tables are transferred to single submitted_intl_application table, where the data is available for download and reporting.

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Note: Some fields are never available for download or reporting, such as social security numbers, sexual orientation, transgender identification, etc. Instead, these fields are encrypted, and are only available, anonymously and with no connection to any other application data, for reporting at the California Community College Chancellor's Office (CCCO). CCCApply International Submitted Application Database Tables

When a CCCApply International Application is in progress, data entered is written to individual "in-progress" tables defined by their category and not accessible. When the application is finally submitted, all the data is written to a single submitted_intl_application table that contains all of the data from the in-progress tables (with the exception of protected information, which is encrypted never viewable by the colleges, such as social security number, sexual orientation, and transgender status). The submitted_intl_application table is the data source for reporting and downloads.
