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Hello Patty and all-

As always Patty, this looks great! I have a few recommendations:

Under 2b for residency requirements (or additional requirements):

Changes to residency determination for non-credit

Since residency is not going to be collected for non-credit students, we should recommended that colleges code non-credit applicants as non-residents by default. Additionally, colleges should consider not allowing non-credit applicants to enroll in credit courses <u>unless</u> they have either reapplied as a credit student or have submitted a residency reclassification form.

Changes to available data for reporting

Moreover, since residency data for non-credit students will no longer be collected, colleges need to be aware of the missing MIS data that they will now be responsible to collect for all non-credit students. I think these recommendations are important to include since there are big holes in legislation that could have serious ramifications when a college is being audited or attempting to report data. Colleges will now be more responsible for collecting follow-up data to do their jobs.

Thank you to everyone who attended the CCCApply Non-Credit meeting last Thursday, October 11. (Please forward this to anyone that I missed who either attended or responded.)

The purpose of this email is to provide a recap of everything that was discussed during the meeting, and request your feedback and acknowledgment of the detailed change requirements captured to implement a "Non-credit Path" in the CCCApply Standard application in order to comply with the new legislation passed in Assembly Bill 3101 - which

exempts non-credit students from residency determination and collects only the data required by federal, state, and other necessary requirements at the time of application. The revision to include this new residency exempt path also requires other changes that would allow the student to re-apply to the same term, same college - if the student changes status and then decides to enroll in "for credit" courses.

Hello Omid,

As requested, this email thread contains the CCCApply non-credit path change request and additional information from the sub-committee meeting held on October 11. There's a lot of information included but here's a synopsis FWIW:

A sub-committee convened a meeting to discuss a change request proposal to enhance CCCApply to support non-credit students who are now exempt from residency requirements.

The email and the embedded links document the proposal as discussed and acknowledged by the CCC college staff that attended the meeting.

I have asked the meeting attendees to reply to the email to officially acknowledge - or better, approve - the change request details in order to move this closer to approval for development.

There are several open items that need to be finalized within the change proposal:

- The language and response options in the new Course Credit Status question (that would be added to the Enrollment page)
- The language in the confirmation pop-up box (which triggers the non-credit path of guestions)
- The language in the Help pop-up box(es) that is proposed
- The process & validation logic for allowing or restricting a student to transition from non-credit to credit within the same term or subsequent term

I also added a PPT with a mock-up of what the path would look like, based on the current state of this change request right now. It may be buried in the thread below, so here it is for your convenience: **CCCApply Non-Credit Path**Proposal
