

Cataloging: OCLC Reclamation Project Update

The Cataloging Work Group recommends the following guidelines with regards to the OCLC Reclamation Project:

Background:

- The Network Zone (NZ) is to be populated with the holdings from all libraries in the CCL LSP consortium.
- The OCLC number is the matching point for:
 - Identifying and avoiding duplicates in the NZ
 - Determining the match between the record in the NZ and its corresponding OCLC master record.
- All bibliographic records (except for those specific to a library such as course reserves, equipment, etc...) should have an OCLC number.
- The OCLC Reclamation Project provides the opportunity for bibliographic records that lack an OCLC number to be assigned an OCLC number.

Timeline:

- The Cataloging Work Group recommends performing the OCLC Reclamation Project after “Go Live” (spring 2020).
 - The project will require time, effort and a point person from each college participating in the reclamation.
 - Many librarians/staff are away for the summer and will need time to prepare for cutover data extracts in fall 2019.
 - If the reclamation happens after “Go Live”, the bib extracts can come from one standardized location (Alma) rather than individual legacy ILSs.
 - The OCLC Reclamation Project will need to be completed before June 2020.

Next Steps:

- The California Community Colleges have contracted for a consortial reclamation with OCLC.
- All institutions are included in the contract, but it is up to each institution to participate.
- The assumption is that WMS (OCLC legacy ILS) libraries likely do not need to participate in the Reclamation Project.
- The Reclamation Project aims to increase the percentage of records linking to the NZ to at least 50% for each institution.
- The following data is based off of recent Ex Libris migration statistics. Please keep in mind that these numbers include all records such as course reserves and equipment that would not populate the Network Zone.
- The Cataloging Work Group preliminarily recommends Institutions #1-17 participate in the Reclamation Project based on the high percentage of records that failed to link to the NZ.
- The Cataloging Work Group suggests Institutions #18-39 evaluate their data to determine whether the Reclamation Project would be beneficial.

- The Cataloging Work Group anticipates that Institutions #40-82 may want to opt-out of the Reclamation Project based on the low percentage of records that failed to link to the NZ.
- More information will be forthcoming in the fall semester about final timelines and how to participate.
