

#### Phase One: July 2018-June 2020

- Development & Implementation Phase:
  - Creation of the Cataloging Work Group
  - Establishment of the framework for the Cataloging wiki page
  - Research and consultation with other consortial networks
  - Development of documentation in consultation with Jessica Hartwigsen (NZ Manager)
  - Differentiation between policies, best practices, and recommendations based on what worked best for the CCC consortium:
    - Policies (required)
    - Best Practices (operational)
    - Recommendations (suggested, but not necessarily operational)

#### Phase Two: July 2020+

- Revision and Refinement Phase:
  - Now that we are live and actively working in the new shared environment, the policies, best practices, and recommendations of the Cataloging Work Group will need to be refined when needed and reviewed annually.
  - As the ERM/Acquisitions Work Group finalize their policies and best practices, we will need to make adjustments when necessary so the policies continue to complement each other.
  - As libraries incorporate these policies and best practices into their work flows, we will receive input from the field. The Cataloging Work Group should take these suggestions into consideration in the revision and refinement phase of this project.

#### **Reclamation Project Update**

#### Participants:

- 62 colleges have had their files accepted by OCLC
- 16 colleges are still pending for tomorrow/Monday
- o 30 colleges declined to participate and 2 colleges were non-responsive

#### Updates:

- 16 colleges have been sent their reports, but the team opted to hold onto the remaining reports until directions for handling them were finalized. Those directions will be distributed along with the reports early next week (prior to Wednesday's webinar).
- Lastly, we just received the subscription agreement from OCLC that will allow Jessica to perform the query collection in the NZ. We expect that to be up and running within 7-10 days.
