Hi Mitch,

Absolutely. We didn't choose our words accurately. It's not that this is functioning the way it should be - it's that the functionality was not setup to function that way. So, from a technical perspective, this isn't a bug, it's a change enhancement. I've got it written up and we'll have to prioritize if this is more important than the other 20 or 30 enhancements pending. Since this only affects a very small percentage of users (this is the first time I've been aware of this use case) it's lower priority right now. We will discuss this at the upcoming meeting and see if there is an urgent need to bump this above others.
