Hi Mitch,

I looked into this frustrating phenomenon and here's the triggering question:

Parent/Guardian Information

By California law, qualification for resident tuition is based on the residency of your parent(s) or guardian(s) until you are 19 years of age, except in certain special circumstances. The following questions will be used to determine whether or not you need to provide parent or guardian information for the purposes of determining residency. Your response will not affect your admission to college.

Select the statement that applies to you:

At least one of the following statements is true about me.

- I am or have been married.
 I am legally <u>emancipated</u>.
 I do not have a living parent or guardian.
 As of 06/18/2017, I will be on active duty in the armed services.
 As of 06/18/2017, I will have been <u>self-supporting</u> for at least one year.
- None of the statements above is true about me.

I suspect that the reason so many students answer this question incorrectly is that they skim over the list of statements and don't notice the "None of the statements above is true about me" option that is separate from "At least one of the following" so they simply move past the list without marking either answer. When they try to go to the next page, the following message pops up:



I think when students receive this they think they have to select "At least one of the following..." in order to move on, because that is the answer that is highlighted with a red box to signify the question is unanswered. (see screen clip above with "At least..." highlighted in red - that is what happens after the error message pops up)
