Hi Patty,

After listening in last Friday's meeting where you reviewed the non-credit application, I had some questions. I spoke to our dean regarding the topic of having students be both credit and non-credit and what would be done regarding how those students would fill out the application. Before we can even consider putting out guidance regarding this issue I need to understand it better. Can you help me understand with answering my questions below. I apologize for putting more work on your plate, I hope answering my questions won't take too much of your time.

1. When a student complete the credit application, will the student be able to view non-credit courses (or vise-versa)? If they can view non-credit, can they enroll?
2. I remember you saying there was an "NC" in the student's ID number if the student completes a non-credit, is that right? If so, does that mean a student would have two ID numbers if the student completes both applications?
3. I see in the notes there is "standard, noncredit, both". Is there an application being developed for students who want both credit and/or non-credit or would the student need to choose either or.

I can see the problem this can create for students because some schools are implementing co-requisite courses that are non-credit for courses that are credit. Combining a sequence of both non-credit and credit sounds like a nightmare if where we are headed to is two separate applications with no ability for them to be combined in special circumstances.
