


The Vision + Digital Equity

CCCApply Update


- Consultation Council and Accenture
- Short-term Working Group (STWG)
 - Met February April
 - Established timelines / goals for Task Force
 - Collected feedback through last week
- Task Force timeline
 - Kick-off in September 2023
 - Meetings scheduled through May 2024
 - Communication plan uses multiple methods to inform all stakeholders



Common, systemwide ERP

- No Budget Change Proposal (BCP) for 23/24
- Next step: Current state analysis
 - Soon through fall 2023
 - Direct contact with colleges/districts to map a system profile
 - Versions in use (add to application profile)
 - Modules in use (SIS, HR, Finance, etc.)
 - Functionality in use
 - Establish plan
 - Inform timelines
 - Create Task Force
 - Define BCPs





2023 TTAC Retreat

2023 Retreat Context

- Since 2020, significant changes for the system and IT exacerbated by structural issues
- TTAC/SAC challenges independent of the pandemic:
 - Systemwide representation (i.e., small vs. large, single vs. multi-college, urban vs. suburban vs. rural colleges/districts, etc.)
 - Attendance by colleges/districts
 - Communication flows between agency, TTAC, other stakeholder groups (e.g., SAC and DEETAC), and the field generally



2023 Retreat Purpose

To attend to:

- Planning and collaborative engagement needed from the field
- Obtain feedback on proposed FY23+ IT goals and roadmap
- Solicit input on systemwide technology funding strategy in FY23+
- Validate TTAC and SAC as part of the system's participatory governance framework (i.e., purpose, relationship to other groups, membership, documentation, etc.)



Informing a Systemwide Technology Agenda

- What are your college/district or stakeholder group's top two business priorities, and why?
- What technology challenges are you facing to support these priorities? and why?
- What NEW system-level technology investments would you want the system to consider in the next two years, and why?


- What other challenges have not been named (i.e., related to TTAC and IT in the system more broadly)?


